

Attendance Appeals Process

Our BLET Western Lines General Committee has sought court action since the implementation of UP's latest Attendance Policy based on a point system.

In addition to the lawsuit we will also start appealing any layoff, for each member, that has had points assessed to him/her. What we need from the members is to print off their attendance history found on the MYUP screen, put your employee ID number on it and put it in your Division box at the yard office. Your attendance monitor will print out a 90 day snapshot. If you have had points assessed in the past 60 days print it off and put it in the box. Going forward every layoff that you are assessed points, please follow the same process of printing off history as soon as possible for further handling.

We will continue fighting this policy at every opportunity we can and with whatever tools are at our disposal. Your Local Chairman cannot see your attendance monitor, so we need each member to participate in order for this to be effective. Please forward your information as soon as possible.
